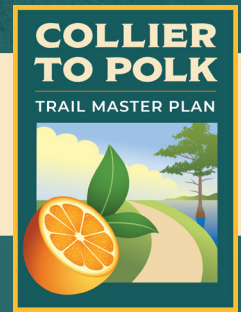


THE COLLIER TO POLK REGIONAL TRAIL MASTER PLAN PUBLIC OPEN HOUSES

PROJECT DETAILS

The Collier to Polk Regional Trail Master Plan development project is a partnership project coordinated by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The Master Plan will evaluate, define, and chart the course for advancement of a regional multi-use trail traversing Collier, Hendry, Glades, Highlands, Hardee, and Polk counties.

A connected trail system offers the potential to maximize economic, active transportation, ecotourism, and healthy recreation benefits.

The Master Plan, which will be completed by Summer 2024, is defining potential trail routing opportunities as part of the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Network.
